



The Policy definitions of Europe include the following::

“EUROPE” means Albania, Algeria (north of 30° north), Andorra, Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan (excluding Nagorno-Karabakh), Belarus, Belgium, Bulgaria, Channel Islands, Croatia, Czech Republic, Denmark, Estonia, Egypt (north of 30° north), Faroe Islands, Finland, France, Georgia, Germany, Gibraltar, Greece, Greenland, Hungary, Ireland, Iceland, Islands within the Adriatic, Aegean – Black - Ionian and Mediterranean Seas, Isle of Man, Italy, Latvia, Libya (north of 30° north), Liechtenstein, Lithuania, Luxembourg, Macedonia, Moldova, Monaco, Montenegro, Morocco, Netherlands, Norway, Poland, Portugal (including the Azores and Madeira), Romania, Russia (West of 60° East excluding Checheno/Ingushskaya), Serbia (excluding Kosovo), San Marino, Slovakia, Slovenia, Spain (including the Canary Islands), Sweden, Switzerland, Tunisia, Turkey, Ukraine, United Kingdom, Vatican City and transit airspace between these countries, principalities and territories.

However, coverage is granted for the over flight of any excluded territory, Algeria, and Bosnia-Herzegovina where the flight is within an internationally recognised air corridor and is performed in accordance with I.C.A.O. recommendations.

In addition to those countries listed above coverage is excluded for any flight into any country where such operation of aircraft is in breach of United Nations sanctions.
